Human beings must acquire the kokoro to give back as they live in a world that revolves around the unmei-jittai (the kokoro).

The kokoro to give back blooms when you grow up in a family where harmony is fostered.

To the Shinja

Learn the teachings with your family members and strive repeatedly with them to create a family that lives by the principles.

The unmei (the kokoro) of family members comes together and their jittai will be filled with love.

The teachings raise your interest in family members, and a family where conversations never cease is created.

The kokoro to give back—the compassionate interest (kokoro) in all people and all living things—is fostered.

Work must not be seen as labor that supports your livelihood.

When you gain the kokoro to give back, human beings make the best of the people and things they encounter; outcomes are elevated when their unmei mutually comes together, is supported and enhanced.

The best is made of all encounters in society, at the workplace, at schools, in communities, and in the family.

If you are dissatisfied with the environment that you live in today (now), live by the teachings and correct your jittai.

The Shinji—the principles—gives the kokoro of the shinja awareness and draws out the understanding to live with the kokoro to give back.

The outcome of your work improves when you live with the kokoro to give back.
