As you perceive the era, you will know why politics and the economy are institutions (powers) that cannot protect society.

No matter how deeply humanity learns about history, they are unable to perceive the path that should be.

No matter how much humanity researches and analyzes medicine and the sciences, they are unable to elucidate the mysteries.

Kami reveals the principles to society (the world) through Shisha so that humanity can live a life without regrets and remain unconsumed by the present era where there are no principles.

When shinja live their life sustained by the teachings, they will walk the correct path and attain a life of kaiun.

Summary of the Shinji

This world and every person's life—everything revolves around the *unmei-jittai*. The movement of the *kokoro* of people, who have been able to draw out their *unmei's* strengths which are the good elements, is protected and they will live a life of much meaning and purpose. However, when your life is led by your *jittai*, your *kokoro* will be filled with doubts and you will live a life of many troubles and much suffering.

When you understand this, it is important to strive to correct your *jittai* so that your *unmei's* strengths are drawn out and you become useful in this world. Therefore, learn the *Shinji* to gain this understanding.

When you try to understand the *Shinji* based on the norms of society, there may be times when you will find it difficult to be convinced. This is because the conventional wisdom that prevails in societies constructs the world around us with knowledge. Knowledge is unreliable and changes. However, the *Shinji* is principles and when the world is seen based on the *Shinji*, you will perceive what is distorted and what needs to be corrected.

The *Shinji* teaches us how to live out a life without regrets. When you see the movements in the world through the *Shinji*, you will know what is right and what is wrong. And when the teachings sustain your *kokoro*, you will know what you must never do, or what you must achieve, or what path you must walk—you will begin to perceive the correct path.

In this way, when you live by the way things should be, you will become someone who is useful in society, and be a good influence on your family members and those around you. When you fully show your *unmei's* strengths, your life and the lives of your family members will be protected.

As the era changes, it becomes very clear that politics, the economy, and other forms of human strength and power cannot protect society. No matter how much people learn and study history, they are unable to see the way forward. There are also many things that science cannot resolve.

Kami reveals the *Shinji* through *Shisha* to explain the workings of this world, the way things should be, the path that people should follow as they live their life in a society that has presently lost sight of the principles and the way things should be. If you are a *shinja* who realizes how precious the *Shinji* is, then make them the basis of the way you think as you strive to walk the correct path.

The ability to discern society's movements is to live the correct path and to know what it means to live as a human being. This is when *kaiun* is achieved.
